Sameeksha is fortunate in having access to Pratham's programs to learn to read and write. Not everyone does, and even in fast growing India, illiteracy is still a shocking fact of life. Of India's 210 million children, nearly half are unable to read.

Not only does lack of education dash individual dreams of selffulfillment, it perpetuates cycles of poverty that undermine the viability of India's growth and its economic potential.

Pratham stands out as one of the most influential forces on India's educational system. Seeded by UNICEF in 1994, Pratham began in the slums of Mumbai. Currently, it serves the education needs of underprivileged children across 21 of India's 28 states. Today, it is India's largest nonprofit in the area of primary education creating systematic change that educations hundreds of thousands of children.

HOW DOES PRATHAM HELP?

Driven by its mission to ensure that every child is in school and learning well, Pratham is reaching millions of children in rural and urban areas through a range of education interventions:

- Read India (Phase 2), Pratham's flagship program, has become a nationwide movement and works with communities, parents and governments to ensure that children ages 6 - 14 have grade-appropriate reading, writing and arithmetic skills
- Preschools for underprivileged children
- Outreach programs targeting street children
- Special courses focused on such subjects as computers and English
- Remedial education for students not performing at grade-level and for out-of-school children
- · Vocational and skill training to prepare students for employment

PRATHAM'S 'READ INDIA' PROGRAM TODAY

Pratham selected 200 districts across India where it maintains a sustained presence for a minimum of three years. In each district, Pratham sets up either a District or a Block Resource Center through which the program is implemented. Approximately 1 million children have been impacted and about 200,000 volunteers have been trained in Pratham's pedagogy.

Pratham's Combined Activities for Maximized Learning, or CAMal, combines reading, writing and speaking activities so that these competencies all develop simultaneously. Another feature of CAMal is the inclusion of whole class activities, small group activities, and individual activities. The methodology can be used to achieve learning goals both at the basic and higher levels.

Children are taught by Pratham volunteers trained in Pratham's teaching and assessment techniques. Pratham also equips volunteers with teaching and learning materials that are published in local languages and graded according to their level of difficulty.

Creating Large Scale Educational Reform In India



Pratham works in 21 states with communities, parents, and governments to:

- Provide educational programs
- Create educational standards
- Measure actual learning levels
- Advocate for educational reform
- Test innovative programs
- Facilitate local solutions

We do this through programs that reach children throughout the educational spectrum. From pre-school to primary and vocational schooling, Pratham opens the door to a world of opportunity and a brighter future.



WHAT HAS PRATHAM ACHIEVED?

- 34 million children in more than 304,000 villages across
 19 states have been reached by phase 1 of Read India.
- 448,000 volunteers and 605,000 teachers have been trained in Pratham's innovative techniques
- 700,000 children in 16,000 villages tested by Pratham's ASER (Annual Status of Education Report) has resulted in the Indian government taking action with a revealing national picture of learning levels
- 39,000 children have been schooled in Pratham preschools.
- Over 20,000 children were taught to speak and read English



Producing Measurable Results

From 2008–2010, Pratham trained 89% of Punjab teachers, helping raise the reading level of 5th graders across the state from 35% to 62%.

2008 Before Pratham's Intervention2010 After Pratham's Intervention






HOW YOU CAN GET INVOLVED AND MAKE A DIFFERENCE
